

COMMINGLED RECYCLING RULES

NO PLASTIC BAGS IN COMMINGLED RECYCLING

ANY COMMINGLED RECYCLING PLACED IN PLASTIC BAGS,
OR CONTAINERS THAT HAVE PLASTIC BAGS IN THEM

WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.

YOU MUST REMOVE ALL PLASTIC BAGS BEFORE
PLACING RECYCLABLES OUT FOR COLLECTION.

ONLY PLASTIC ITEMS MARKED #1, 2 OR 5 IN THE
ARROW SYMBOL ARE RECYCLABLE.



ALL RECYCLABLES MUST BE RINSED AND FREE OF DEBRIS
BEFORE BEING PLACED OUT FOR COLLECTION.

NEVER INCLUDE IN RECYCLING:

NO plastic bags, **NO** styrofoam, **NO** packing material, **NO** plastic wrap,
NO shrink wrap, **NO** pots/pans/cookware, **NO** utensils, **NO** ceramic plates/cups,
NO metal or plastic hangers, **NO** light bulbs, **NO** soiled recyclables,
NO paper packaging with plastic or foil.

THESE ITEMS SHOULD BE PLACED IN THE TRASH.

Plastic bags should be reused, repurposed, returned to a store that
has a collection program, or put in the regular trash.

THE ABOVE RULES APPLY TO BOTH CURBSIDE
RECYCLING COLLECTION AND RECYCLING DROPPED OFF AT THE
RECYCLING CENTER.

TURN OVER FOR PAPER AND CARDBOARD RECYCLING RULES

PAPER AND CARDBOARD RECYCLING RULES

NO PLASTIC BAGS IN PAPER RECYCLING

**ANY PAPER OR CARDBOARD RECYCLING PLACED IN PLASTIC BAGS,
OR CONTAINERS THAT HAVE PLASTIC BAGS IN THEM**

WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.

**YOU MUST REMOVE ALL PLASTIC BAGS,
STYROFOAM AND PACKING MATERIALS
BEFORE PLACING PAPER AND CARDBOARD OUT FOR COLLECTION.**

Accepted Items: Newspaper, junk mail, envelopes, smooth or corrugated cardboard, office/notebook/construction paper, computer/fax/copy paper, shredded paper, magazines, catalogs, telephone and paperback books, brown grocery bags, non-metallic wrapping paper and greeting cards.

NEVER INCLUDE IN RECYCLING:

NO plastic bags, **NO** pizza boxes, **NO** styrofoam, **NO** packing material,
NO paper soiled with grease/food/paint, **NO** wax coated paper,
NO paper cups, **NO** tissues/paper towels,
NO paper packaging with plastic or foil, **NO** hardcover books.

THESE ITEMS SHOULD BE PLACED IN THE TRASH.

Plastic bags should be reused, repurposed, returned to a store that has a collection program, or put in the regular trash.
