I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for all children participating in youth sports by following this Parents' code of Ethics:

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or their youth sports event.

I will place the emotional and physical well being of all players ahead of any competitive desire to defeat the opposing team.

I will cooperate to see that all children play in a safe and healthy environment.

I recognize that my child's coach is trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach will uphold the Coaches' Code of Ethics.

I will support coaches and officials working with my child and all other players in order to encourage a positive enjoyable experience for all players, coaches, and officials.

I will promote a sports environment for my child and all other players that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and will refrain from use of the same at all youth sports events.

I acknowledge that the games are for the children – not adults and are to encourage good sportsmanship, not competition.

I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for all children, coaches, and officials.

I will demand my child treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless race, sex, creed, ability, or disability.

I will help all children enjoy their youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being respectful fan, supporting coaches, or providing transportation in a reasonable and safe manner.
