

NOTICE OF EMPLOYMENT

The Borough of Cresskill will be accepting applications for the position of Firefighter. Applications may be picked up at the Cresskill Borough Hall, 67 Union Avenue between February 6 and 9, 2012 between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Application with resume must be returned to Borough Administrator no later than February 10, 2012 at 3:00 p.m.

To be hired as a Cresskill Firefighter, you must:

- Be a United States Citizen at the time of employment
- Preference will be given (1) to persons who have served in the Cresskill Fire Department as active volunteer fire fighters for at least 2 years next preceding the appointment or those volunteer firefighters with exemption certificates; then (2) residents of Cresskill; then (3) other Bergen County residents; then (4) other residents of New Jersey.
- Must be available for immediate hire
- Must be sound in body and of good health sufficient to satisfy the Borough Physician and the Board of Trustees of the Police and Firemen's Retirement System of New Jersey as to eligibility for membership in the retirement system
- Must be of good moral character and has not been convicted of any criminal offense involving moral turpitude
- Must be able to read, write and speak the English language well and intelligently.
- Must hold a valid New Jersey Motor Vehicle Driver's License at the date of employment
- Must have a four (4) year high school diploma or its educational equivalent
- Must have attained the age of 21 years through 35 years, or 40 years if appointed pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-42 through 44.

In addition, you will be required to be a Certified First Responder with Defibrillation (CFR-D) by the end of your probationary period. Cresskill Fire Department provides a CFR-D training program during the probationary Firefighter period
