WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Cresskill authorize the Borough's Departments to purchase those certain items from an approved New Jersey State Contract Vendor within the thresholds hereinafter stated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Cresskill hereby authorizes the Borough's Departments to purchase the following items from an approved New Jersey State Contract Vendor within the thresholds specifically stated as contained in Exhibit A annexed hereto and made a part hereof; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Cresskill, that pursuant to the rules of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey no amount of this contract shall be chargeable or certified until such time as goods are ordered or otherwise called for prior to placing the order and a certification of availability of funds is made by the Chief Financial Officer upon receipt of a properly executed purchase order. The individual issuing the purchase order shall have the obligation of securing the necessary certification as to the availability of funds from the Chief Financial Officer; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this authorization shall be until December 31, 2011 or upon the expiration of the vendor's State Contract, whichever event occurs first.

BE IT RESOLVED that the amount of interest to be paid at the rate of Eight (8%) percent or Twelve (12%) percent, as the case may be, as provided for in this Resolution, shall be computed from the first day of the current quarter unless the taxes for such quarter are paid during the first ten (10) days of said quarter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector be authorized to hold the annual Tax Sale on delinquent taxes as required by P.L. 1997 Chapter 99.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the period of such use and exemption extend through the year 2011 unless certain unforeseeable events should occur, in which case the Department will be furnished with reasonable notice of discontinuance; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Cresskill Volunteer Fire Department and the Cresskill Volunteer Firemen's Association shall be furnished copies of this resolution by the Borough Clerk.
