

BOROUGH OF CRESSKILL

ORDINANCE NO. 11-20-1422

AMEND CHAPTER 30 – FIRE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Cresskill in the County of Bergen and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I 30-8. Applicable procedures for membership; classification of members.

- (4) Life Member
Life Member status shall be bestowed upon all members who have served 25 years as an Active Fire Fighter with the Cresskill Fire Department. Life Members who are still on the Fire Department rolls shall be entitled to a clothing allowance, Cresskill Municipal Pool rebate and additional benefits when and if made available.
- (5) Ex-Chief
Ex-Chief status shall be bestowed upon all members who have served as Chief of Cresskill Fire Department. Ex-Chiefs who are still on the Fire Department rolls shall be entitled to a clothing allowance, Cresskill Municipal Pool rebate and additional benefits when and if made available.

SECTION II 30-9. Election of officers.

- G. There shall be no time limit to the office of the Fire Chief. He can be reelected to the office at the pleasure of the Department Members. However, no ex-Chief, unless serving as a Cresskill fire officer, shall be eligible to run again for the office of Fire Chief until he has again served at the rank of Captain or lower for one year, except in the event that there is no other candidate qualified to run the office of Chief as set forth in this code.

SECTION III 30.12. Practice drills.

Practice drills shall be held whenever ordered by the Chief of the Department. Drills shall be held at least once a month from January 1 to November 1 and at such other times during the calendar year as shall be ordered by the Chief of the Department.

SECTION IV

All other Ordinances of the Borough, or parts thereof, which are in conflict with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION V

If any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or sentence of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall apply only to the section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION VI

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
