ORDINANCE NO. 19-17-1548

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE GENERAL ORDINANCE
OF THE BOROUGH OF CRESSKILL, COUNTY OF BERGEN,
SPECIFICALLY, CHAPTER 170 ARTICLE II §170-24,
ENTITLED “WHITE GOODS”**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Cresskill, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, all provisions of Chapter 170, Article II, §170-24, is amended and replaced in its entirety as follows:

§170-24 Metal Recycling

All metal items including washing machines, refrigerators, stoves and household appliances must be recycled. Metal items are collected on the first Friday of every month. Residents must call the Public Works Department prior to the scheduled collection date to have metal picked up. Metal items shall not be placed at the curb prior to the night before the scheduled collection date. Residents may also drop off metal items at the Recycling Center during normal operating hours.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, the Council readopts the remaining provisions of the Ordinance as stated therein;

SEVERABILITY. If the provisions of any article, section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this ordinance shall be judged invalid in whole or in part or as applied to any particular circumstance or individual by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not effect or invalidate the remainder of any article, section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this ordinance.

REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies only.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
