ORDINANCE NO. 22-03-1585

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 53-19 POLICE DEPARTMENT  
COMPOSITION OF THE BOROUGH OF CRESSKILL IN THE COUNTY OF  
BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Cresskill Police Department, through retirement attrition, has changed composition, as more fully described in Chapter 53, Article III, Department Organization, Appointments and Promotions §53-19, Composition, thus requiring an Amendment to the Ordinance; and

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, the Council does hereby rescind the current §53-19, Composition, in its entirety;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, the following is a new §53-19 Composition, which will read as follows upon adoption:

“The Police Department shall consist of no more than, but not necessarily, one Chief, one Deputy Chief, two Captains, two Lieutenants, seven Sergeants and seventeen patrolpersons. The Chief, Deputy Chief, Captain, Lieutenants, Sergeants, patrolpersons and special officers, as may from time to time be necessary, shall be appointed to these positions by resolutions of the Mayor and Council., The position of Deputy Chief shall sunset upon retirement of the Police Chief”

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,

Any article, section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or other provision of the Ordinances of the Borough of Cresskill inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
