

ANIMAL CONTROL DEER CARCASS REMOVAL

Please note the Municipality has a Shared Service with the County Board of Health. If you have a dead deer carcass on your private property or you see one on public roads or land, please note the following:

1. Report a deceased deer carcass to the Cresskill Police Department at 201-568-1400.
2. The Carcass shall be removed by a NJDEP License transporter.
3. It can take up to 72 hours to remove the carcass.
4. It will be taken to a disposal facility license to receive carcasses.

Animal Control staff are available 24 hours per day, 7 Days a week.
