### **Community Safety Reminders:**

#### **Speeding Concerns**

- Enforcement efforts are increasing to address speeding concerns throughout the community and will remain proactive.

#### **Parking Guidelines**

- Problem areas, including Union Avenue, Allen Street, and Mezzine Drive, will continue to be monitored and enforced.

### **Reminder as we approach the July E-Bike Law compliance deadline:**

#### **New Jersey E-Bike Law (Effective July 19, 2026)**

- In **January 2026**, Governor Murphy signed legislation S4834/A6235, establishing new

statewide regulations for e-bikes.

- All e-bikes are now classified as “motorized bicycles.”
- E-bike riders are required to obtain a license and registration through the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (NJMVC).
- Riders have until **July 19, 2026** to meet the licensing and registration requirements.
- NJMVC procedures for licensing and registration are now available through the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission.

• This law significantly changes e-bike use in New Jersey by treating e-bikes similarly to motorized vehicles.
