#### 11. RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY VIA ON-LINE AUCTION

WHEREAS, the Borough of Cresskill is the owner of certain surplus property which is no longer needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Cresskill is desirous of selling said surplus property in an "as is" condition without express or implied warranties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Cresskill, as follows:

- 1. The sale of surplus property shall be conducted through GovDeals pursuant to State Contract A-70967/T2581 in accordance with the terms and conditions of the State Contract. The terms and conditions of the agreement entered into with GovDeals is available online at govdeals.com and also available from the Borough of Cresskill.
- 2. The sale will be conducted online and the address of the auction is govdeals.com.
- 3. The sale is being conducted pursuant to Local Finance Notice 2008-9.
- 4. A list of the surplus property to be sold is indicated on Schedule A attached hereto.

- 5. The surplus property as identified shall be sold in an "as is" condition without express or implied warranties with the successful bidder required to execute a Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement concerning use of said surplus property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Cresskill, County of Bergen, New Jersey as follows:

#### 17. RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF DEMAREST FOR CONSOLIDATION OF THEIR MUNICIPAL COURTS

WHEREAS, The Borough of Cresskill and the Borough of Demarest have agreed to enter into a Interlocal Services Agreement for their respective Municipal Court services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Cresskill, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The Interlocal Services Agreement between the Borough of Cresskill and the Borough of Demarest for consolidation of the Municipal Courts is approved. The terms and conditions of the Agreement, pursuant to N.J.S.A 40A:65-1, et seq, any municipality of the State of New Jersey may contract with any other municipality or municipalities for the shared provision within their several jurisdictions of any service that any party to the agreement is empowered to provide within its own jurisdiction, and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1(c), two resolutions, or more municipalities, by ordinance or resolution, may agree to share services for courtrooms, chambers, equipment, supplies and employees for their municipal courts and agree to appoint the same employee including, but not limited to, municipal judges, court administrators, prosecutors public defenders and security personnel without establishing a joint municipal court.
- 2. The Mayor and Borough Clerk are authorized to sign the Interlocal Services Agreement on behalf of the Borough.
- 3. The Interlocal Services Agreement is subject to final approval by the Borough Administrator and Borough Attorney. This resolution shall be void and of no effect in the event that the Borough of Demarest fails or refuses to sign the Interlocal Agreement.
- 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately, and the Interlocal Services Agreement shall take effect January 1, 2024.
- 5. A copy of this Agreement shall be filed, for informational purposes, with the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq.
- 18. WHEREAS, the Council authorized the Borough Clerk to publish Bid Specifications for the Installation of Computer Hardware, and Maintenance and Management Services; and

WHEREAS, Bids were submitted to the Borough Clerk within the time prescribed by the Bid Specifications; and

WHEREAS, the Council reviewed the bids submitted and determined none were responsive to the Maintenance and Management Services; and

WHEREAS, detailed discussion was conducted by Borough Administrator Dianne Lavin and Borough Attorney Christos J. Diktas, Esq., advising the Council as to the Bid irregularities and errors; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the discussion and review of the documents, Councilman Hector Olmo, moved to reject all submitted Bids for the Maintenance and Management, seconded by Councilman Kaplan and

WHEREAS, the Council voted unanimously in a roll call vote, directing the Borough Clerk to advise all vendors that the submitted Bids for Maintenance and Management Services be outright rejected as a result of non-compliance with the bid specification; and

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2023, a Resolution of Bid Award was granted to Fire Rivers, IT Inc., as being the most responsive Hardware and Installation Bidder; and

WHEREAS, the October 18, 2023, Resolution of Bid Award was submitted to Fire River IT, Inc., contained errors, wherein the Resolution incorrectly awarded both the Computer Hardware Installation and the Maintenance and Management Services; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the October 18, 2023, Resolution be rescinded *nun pro tunc* in its entirety for noncompliance with the entire Bid Specifications, and this Resolution be deemed the corrective Resolution, and

BE IT FRUTHER RESOLVED, that the Bid for the Computer Hardware Installation shall be awarded to Five Rivers IT, Inc., for being the most Responsive Bidder, which contract amount shall not exceed THIRTY-SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS (\$37,320.00);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a Certified to be True Copy of this Resolution be tendered to: Five Rivers IT, Inc.; Dianne Lavin, Borough Administrator; Francesca Maragliano, Borough Clerk; and Christos J. Diktas, Esq., Borough Attorney.

19. WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Cresskill directed the Clerk to publish Bid Specification for

AND WHEREAS, three (3) bids were submitted by the following entities:

Five Rivers Information and Technology, Lieberman Networks Inc., and Coban Computer Solutions;

AND WHEREAS, after reviewing the submitted bids the following determination has been made

- 1. Five Rivers Information and Technology's bid is rejected because they failed to include the Bid Guarantee;
- 2. Lieberman Networks Inc.'s bid is rejected as the proposed contractual price exceeds the amount of funds allocated by the Council for this project;
- 3. Coban Computer Solutions' bid is rejected as the Bid Submission does not correspond to the Bid Specifications,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Five Rivers Information and Technology, Lieberman Networks Inc., and Coban Computer Solutions' bids are hereby rejected for the reasons stated herein;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that as a result of not receiving any Responsive Bids for the second time; New Jersey statutes permit the Borough's Representatives to commence negotiations with any and all IT Entities in an attempt to procure a contract for services as outlined in the Bid Specifications

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a Certified to be True Copy of this Resolution be served upon Five Rivers Information and Technology, Lieberman Networks Inc., Coban Computer Solutions, Dianne Lavin, Borough Clerk; Francesca Maragliano, Borough Clerk, and Christos J. Diktas, Esq., Borough Attorney
