

EMERGENCY HEALTH SAFETY AND WELFARE PROCLAMATION
ISSUED BY MAYOR BENEDICT ROMEO

To All Residents and Persons within its Boundaries:

WHEREAS, during the last snow storm, the Borough of Cresskill's Department of Public Works was unable to effectively and safely clear the residential and public roadways from the snow, ice, and debris from the last snow storm; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Residents of the Borough of Cresskill and people withing its boundaries to have residential and public roadways clear of snow, ice, and debris, to ensure their health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the inability to effectively clear the residential and public roadways from snow, ice, and debris creates an emergent public health, safety and welfare issue for the Residents and persons within the Borough's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, in the past, the Borough has effectively cleared the residential and public roadways with Ordinances prohibiting the parking of motor vehicles overnight, however, these Ordinances were rescinded due to overwhelming Public requests; and

WHEREAS, the rescinding of the Ordinances has created a dangerous condition during snow storms to the Residents and persons within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, as the Mayor of the Borough of Cresskill, I am vested with Powers by Chapter 251 of the Laws of 1942, N.J.S.A. App.A:9-40, and N.J.S.A. 40A:60-5, to act as I deem necessary or expedient to ensure the health, safety, welfare and good order of the Borough of Cresskill.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED, that effective immediately, overnight parking on any residential or public roadway is hereby prohibited between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m.; and

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED, that this Emergency Proclamation shall be in effect from January 16, 2024 and shall remain in effect until April 15, 2024, to ensure all residential and public roadways can be effectively and safely cleared of snow, ice, and debris throughout the winter and early spring months; and

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED, that the Cresskill Police Department is hereby authorized to issue a parking summons to any motor vehicle parked in a residential or public roadway between the hours and dates noted herein;
