Everbridge is a robust and highly interactive communication system that allows residents to choose which notifications they receive from different departments, and how they receive them (text, email, or phone). ## FIRE / EMS

### Space Heater Safety

- Check cords for damage or breaks.
- Always place heaters on a flat, stable surface.
- Maintain proper distance between the heater and other objects.

### Chimney Safety

- Have wood-burning chimneys cleaned and inspected regularly.
- Ensure a proper chimney cap is installed.
- Burn only well-seasoned hardwoods in indoor fireplaces.

Never hesitate to call for assistance if you see smoke or smell something burning.

## POLICE

### Overnight Parking Permissions

- Beginning **February 1, 2026**, all overnight parking permission requests must be submitted through the PDLinx website:  
<https://pdlinx.app/parking>
- Approval is not guaranteed. Requests may be denied due to weather conditions or request volume.
- If a request is denied after initially being granted, an email notification will be sent.
- All requests must be submitted **after 8:00 PM**.

### Vehicle Safety Reminder

- Please remove key fobs from your vehicles. While convenient, leaving them inside makes it easier for thieves.

### New Jersey E-Bike Law

- In **January 2026**, Governor Murphy signed **S4834/A6235**, establishing new regulations for e-bikes in New Jersey.
- All e-bikes are now classified as *motorized bicycles* and require licensure and registration.
- E-bike riders have until **July 19, 2026** to obtain the appropriate license and registration through the **New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (NJMVC)**.
- NJMVC procedures are currently under development.
