BOROUGH ADMINISTRATION

Dog & Cat Licensing

- **Due Date:** February 27, 2026
- All dogs and cats **must be licensed** by this date. A late fee will be applied after February 27, 2026.
- Proof of a current rabies vaccination is required.
- For 2026 licensing, the rabies vaccination must be valid through November 1, 2026, unless a written medical exemption is provided by a licensed veterinarian.

Alarm System Registration

- **Due Date:** March 1, 2026
- All residents and businesses with alarm systems are required to complete an application and register annually with the Borough.
- Alarm systems may not be connected to Police Headquarters through the general police number. A dedicated number must be used.

Safety Reminders

- Residents are encouraged to sleep with bedroom doors closed. This simple step can slow the spread of fire and provide critical extra time to escape.
 - Lithium-ion batteries must never be disposed of in household trash. Damaged or improperly discarded batteries can cause fires.
 - Keep an updated list of medications and medical conditions readily accessible in case of a medical emergency.
 - Ensure house numbers are clearly visible from the street so emergency responders can quickly locate your home.

 - Residents must check their email to confirm approval for overnight parking.
 - Vehicles parked overnight without confirmed permission will be subject to summonses.
